

Position Description: Board Vice-Chair

1.1 GENERAL

The Vice-Chair (the "Vice-Chair") of the Board of Directors (the "Board") shall preside over Board meetings in the absence of the Board Chair (the "Board Chair"). In the event of an inability of the Board Chair to fulfill the role, the Vice-Chair shall be called upon to replace the Board Chair until such time that the Board elects a new Board Chair.

1.2 DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

1.2.1 Leadership

When acting as the Board Chair, the Vice-Chair shall act in accordance with the Position Description: Board Chair.

1.2.2 Board Operations

The Vice-Chair serves as a table officer of Central 1.

1.3 ACCOUNTABILITY

The Vice-Chair shall be independent of management and accountable to the Board. The Vice-Chair has no independent authority to act, unless the Board delegates such power to the Vice-Chair.
